W-brand products Nipper Spring

The W-BRAND nipper spring is made to help horseshoers trim the feet on young horses where one-handed nippering on a moving foot is a must. The W-BRAND nipper spring is designed to be easily put on and taken off a variety of hoof nippers. They are not recommended for continual use, especially on larger hooves.

How to put the nipper spring on your hoof nippers:

- 1. Hold the nippers in your left hand with the nipper head pointed away from you. Take the nipper spring and hold it as illustrated (fig 1). Put the handle loop over the handle and slide it about half way up the handle.
- 2. Turn the spring one quarter turn to the left. (fig 2)
- 3. Slide the nipper spring all the way up the handle, (fig 3) and (if possible) around the shoulder of the handle (or as far as the spring will go).

Note: make sure the spring arm is positioned as in figure 3.

4. To secure the nipper spring in place, take one of the enclosed rubber keepers and wrap it around the handle and slide it up to and over the handle loop. The keeper should fit over the handle loop as if faces you (fig 4), and underneath the loop on the opposite side. This will press the coils of the nipper spring solidly against the handle and in its best working position.

End of spring arm is pointed and must travel up and down the nipper handle to work properly. Keep your hand away from this area.
